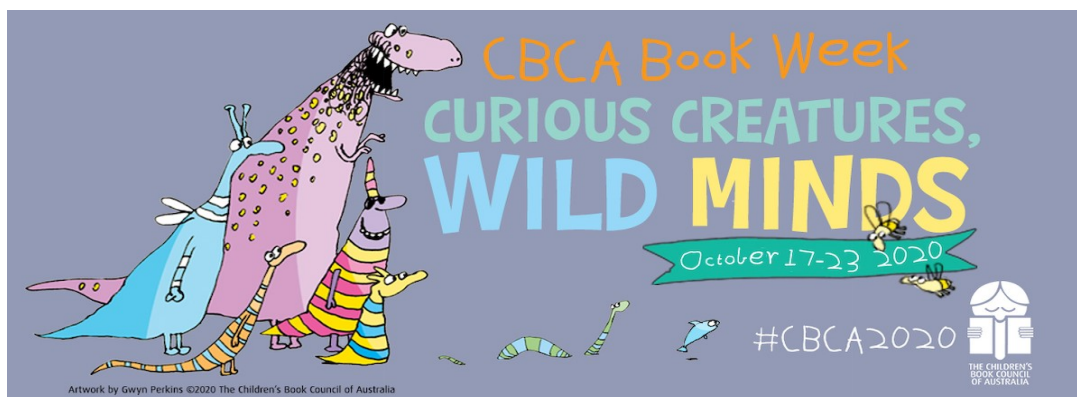

- Enrolments into **local** schools only
- Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
- Children who live in NSW.

Veggie Rice Muffins

Ingredients:

- 2-3 cups chopped/grated vegetables
- 1 clove garlic
- 1 brown onion
- 1/2 cup cooked rice
- 5 eggs
- 2 tablespoons mixed herbs
- 1/2 cup grated cheese

Method:

Preheat oven to 180°C. Grease muffin tins. Brown onion in a small amount of vegetable oil in a pan, then add garlic and other vegetables and cook for 1-2 min. Transfer vegetable mix to a large bowl and add eggs, rice, herbs and cheese. Divide among muffin holes and bake for 20 minutes.
